

Announcing: NNEPA 2009 Conference Poster Contest Rules

1. Poster **must** be the student's original work on 22" X 28" white or colored poster boards.
2. Media may be cut paper, poster paints, charcoal drawings or any suitable art materials. Crayons and colored pencils **cannot** be used for any age group. Poster should not be laminated.
3. NNEPA 2009 Conference theme **must** be clearly indicated on the poster.

“All Life Depends on a Healthy Mother Earth”

4. Name and grade level of student, name and mailing address of school, division in which the poster is to be entered, and parent's name and address should be typed or printed on a 3 X 5 card and attached on the back of the poster in the lower right-hand corner.

Division A - 1st Grade to 5th Grade

Division B - 6th Grade to 8th Grade

Division C - 9th Grade to 12th Grade

Judging:

1. Clarity of Message- The written message should be simple and direct (In Navajo or English, or both).....20 Points
2. Navajo land, water, and air should be protected with individual responsibilities- student's idea of how many to maintain environmental protection on Mother Earth.....20 Points
3. Effectiveness and Attracting Attention – The quality of visual representation.....20 Points
4. Artistic Merit – Art work should stimulate & spark reaction.....20 Points
5. Neatness.....20 Points

Agreement: Submission of an entry to this poster contest signifies the student's agreement to allow NNEPA to reproduce original artwork.

Awards: There will be individual awards for each division and certificates for all entries.
